Title of work: Vol. #. Name of volume (pp. #s). City of Publisher: Publisher.

2. A multi-volume work:

Hagerstown, MD: Review and Herald Publishing Association.

514). Hagerstown, MD: Review and Herald Publishing Association.

Template:

Last Name, First Initial. (Ed.). (Date). Title of Volume. Title of Commentary Multi-volume work.

Vol. # (pp. #'s). City of Publisher: Publisher.

3. Example of a book in a series:

NIV Application Commentary

Wilkins, M. J. (2004). Matthew. In T. Muck (Series Ed.), *The NIV application commentary series*. Grand Rapids, MI: Zondervan.

Template: [A book in a series (Such as the NIV Application Commentary, NICOT, or NICNT).]

Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial (Date). Title of commentary. In Series Editor Name (Series Ed.), Title of Series. City of Publisher: Publisher.

4. Entire book, print version – single author:

Books by E.G. White

White, E. G. (1943). *The story of prophets and kings*. Boise, ID: Pacific Press Publication Association.

White, E. G. (1950). *The desire of ages*. Boise, ID: Pacific Press Publishing Association.

White, E. G. (1950). *The great controversy*. Boise, ID : Pacific Press Publishing Association.

Template:

Last Name, First Initial. Middle Initial. (Date). Title of book. City of Publication: Publisher.
